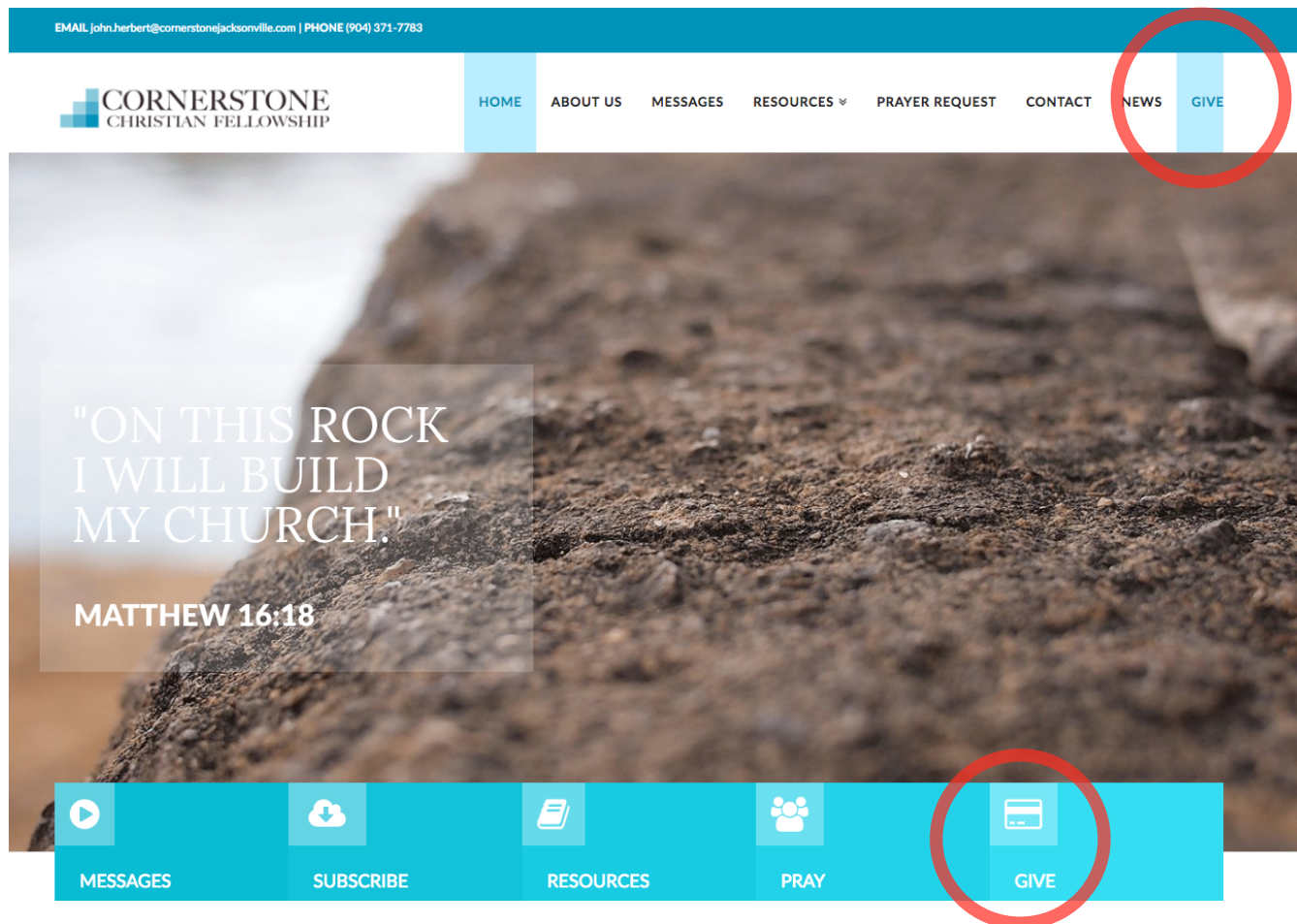


# DEAR CORNERSTONE —

Here is a quick tutorial on how to use our new online tithing feature and additional information on the security standards used to ensure that personal information is not compromised.

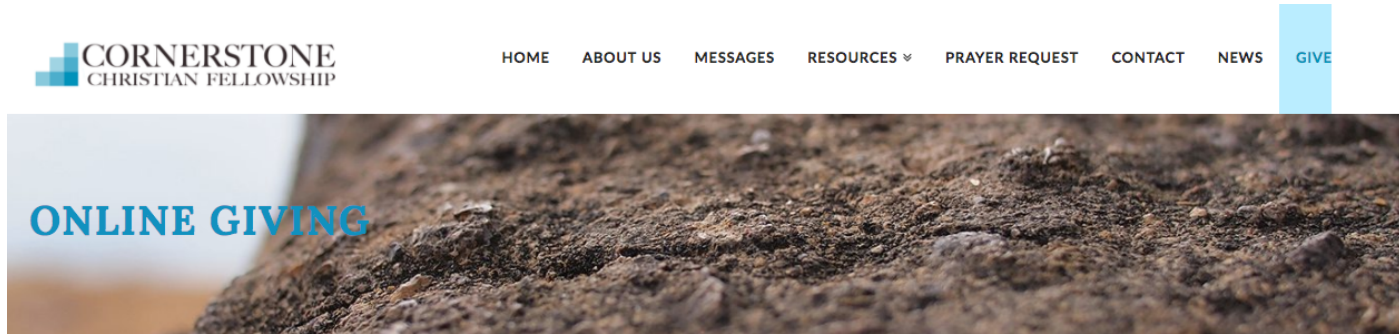
## STEP ONE:

From the [Church website](#) you will click the header “Give”.



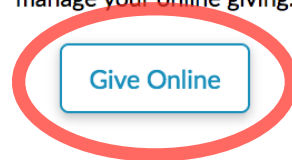
## STEP TWO:

Click "Give Online"



Giving online is simple and secure. Sign in or create an account to schedule and manage payments, access giving history and more!

Create an account to make, schedule and manage your online giving.



You will be redirected to a log-in screen.  
Since this is your first time logging in you will need to create an account.

- Once you have created a new account, you will have the ability to set up your tithe.
- You can determine the frequency of your tithe: weekly, bi-weekly, semi-monthly, monthly, quarterly, or annually.
  - In addition to frequency, you can also determine a start date and amount that is donated based on the schedule you

Once you have set up a scheduled giving amount, you will be able to easily access your donation history online and change the amount given at any time.

The process is extremely simple, it took no more than 5 minutes to sign up and schedule a reoccurring tithe. I hope this is helpful for everyone and is beneficial to our church members local and otherwise.

## **SECURITY - IS MY INFORMATION SECURE?**

### PCI DSS Compliance & Security

As required by the [PCI Security Council](#) and all processing banks, EasyTithe is a Level 1 Certified PCI Compliant Service Provider. This means EasyTithe conforms to the highest set of security standards in the payment card industry. Your account managers, end users, and EasyTithe employees will never have access to the type of sensitive information that might lead to an unauthorized transaction.

### SSL Transaction Security

EasyTithe uses 256 Bit SSL technology for data transactions. All personal, credit card, & bank information is submitted using 256 bit encryption. There is no stronger form of protection than this encryption and by doing this, we eliminate the possibility that someone might "tap" the line and extract your personal data from it. 256-bit SSL encryption has never been broken and according to RSL Labs, it would take a "trillion-trillion years" to crack the code using today's technology.

### The Datacenter

Our datacenter upholds security measures to rigorous standards. Proximity card entry, camera-recorded server room access, and a perimeter security system all protect the datacenter facilities. These security components ensure only employed certified Server Engineers have direct access to the datacenter and individual servers. This restricted

access ensures maximum security when maintaining, upgrading, and troubleshooting servers in the racks.

## **DISCLOSURE, EASY TITHE - CORNERSTONE JAX**

For EACH transaction, EasyTithe™ receives 3.0% and \$0.39. However, in addition to this fee if you use eCheck or ACH an additional 1% and \$.30 is taken out of the transaction.

*Example: For a \$10 gift EasyTithe™ takes  $(\$0.30 + \$0.39) = \$0.69$ . If you use an eCheck/ACH then for a \$10 transaction, they'll take \$1.18 total.*

Your gift is deposited directly to Cornerstone Christian Fellowship's General Church account.
